VALE COMMANDER ARTHUR JOHN (NAT) GOULD

It is with great sadness that we have to report the passing of Nat Gould on Friday 18 January 2019. Nat has always been a great supporter of the Spitfire Association and participated in many of the Association's activities, including the air shows at Temora, the Darwin reunions and our Anzac Day marches.

Nat had an incredible life in the military, from flying Hurricanes in Russia, to flying Spitfires in Darwin against the Japanese and later spending many years in the Royal Australian Navy Fleet Air Arm. He then spent some years with Naval Intelligence in Canberra and then as a Consultant with Hawker de Havilland. Nat, in recent times, also had a great rapport with the Australian War Memorial.
